The Papal Visit to London and Birmingham.

London Saturday 18 September 6-9pm Vigil in Hyde Park.

There is an allocation of 10 places for every parish. There should be a named leader for every group and every parish may parade its own banner. Pilgrims make their own way to London but are asked to contribute £10 towards the cost of a Zone 1 pass on the London Underground and a pilgrim Pack and Pass. There will be a nominated meeting place for all groups in London.

Birmingham Sunday 19 September 10am Mass at Cofton Park, Birmingham for the Beatification of John Henry Newman. All must be in place at Cofton Park by 0830. There is an allocation of 10 places for every parish. Pilgrims will be collected by coach from designated places in the Pastoral Area. Every pilgrim is asked to contribute £25 towards the cost of the coach and the pilgrim pack.

During the Archdiocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes we shall be united with pilgrims in prayer during the daily Masses in our parishes. The pilgrimage starts on Friday 23 July.
